Center for assistance.

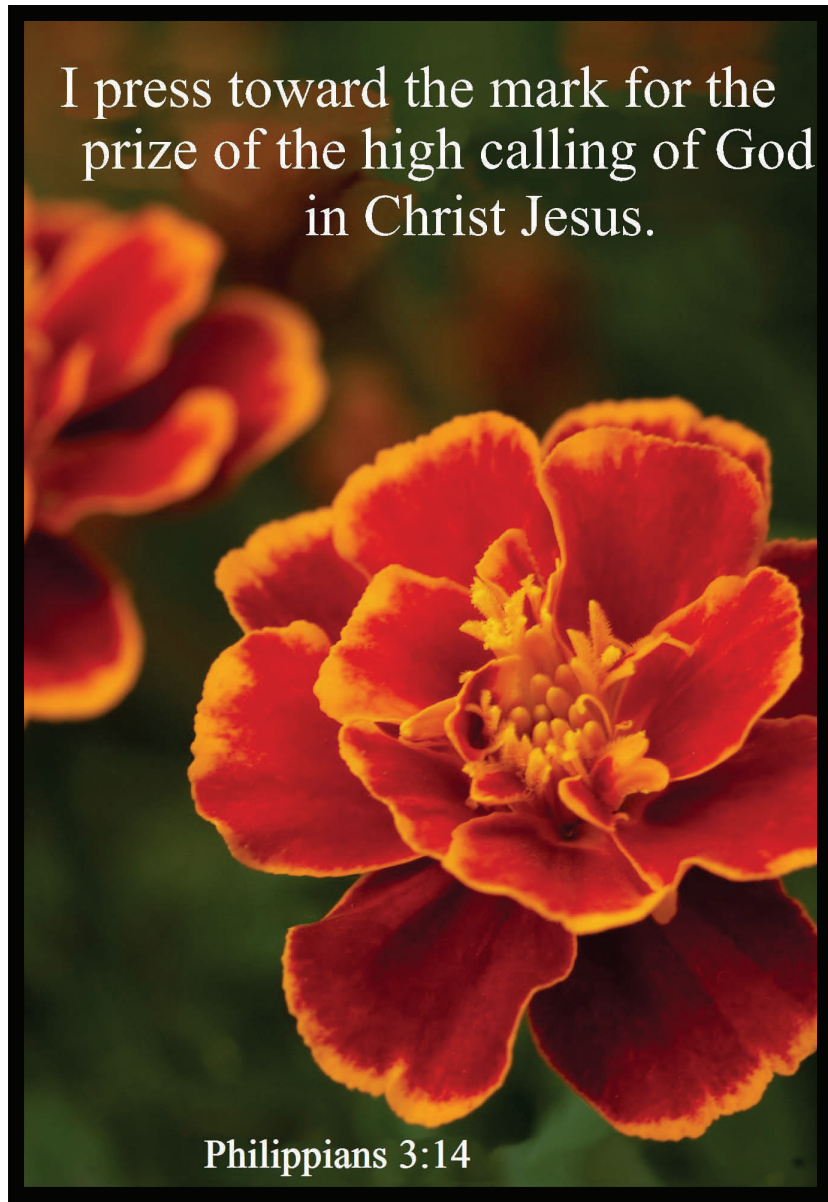
>Children in Sanctuary: Children are welcome to worship with streamers and
