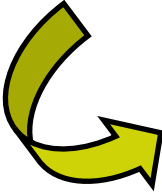

Our Worship Service Protocol

>**Hearing Impaired:** Assisted listening devices are available for the hearing impaired during all services. Contact an usher or stop by the Welcome Center for assistance.

>**Children in Sanctuary:** Children are welcome to worship with streamers and flags located toward the front of the sanctuary. If they are too young to worship on their own, we invite parents to accompany them to help them have a meaningful worship experience. A fully equipped nursery (2yrs-PreK), as well as an infant room, is available.

>**Words to the body:** If you believe you have a word from the Lord, or something to add to the service, we ask that you PLEASE DO NOT approach individuals on the platform. Instead, please speak with the ELDER seated on the front left pew. If you have a prophetic word for an individual, please invite an Elder to cover you as well. Thank You!

>**Ministry within the Body:** Please do not minister to others during the service unless invited by that person. If you feel led to minister to anyone, to respect all those involved, please include a third party. We are striving to keep the altar a safe place.
