approach individuals on the platform. Instead, please speak with the
ELDER seated on the front left pew. If you have a prophetic word for
an individual, please invite an Elder to cover you as well. Thank You!

service unless invited by that person. If you feel led to minister to any-
one, to respect all those involved, please include a third party. We are
striving to keep the altar a safe place.
